

The Role of an Elected Ambassador Dorset Chamber

The role of an elected Ambassador is to represent and act as an Ambassador for Dorset Chamber within the business community. Specifically this is defined as:

- Represent Dorset Chamber at our events, welcoming and engaging with guests.
- On occasion, represent Dorset Chamber at external events or meetings.
- Pro-actively support Dorset Chamber on social media, posting, sharing and commenting on appropriate content.
- Meet as a Council of Ambassadors on a bi-monthly basis to discuss the findings of the quarterly Dorset Chamber membership survey and advise on the development of services we offer.
- Promote and encourage membership of Dorset Chamber within the wider business community.
- Act as an advocate of Dorset Chamber in the business community.
- To discuss the economy and potential services Dorset Chamber could offer to support businesses.

The Council of Ambassadors will be represented on the Dorset Chamber board by the Chair of the Council.

In line with our Articles of Association, an individual holding office as an Ambassador shall cease to do so if they do not **attend three consecutive Council meetings**, unless otherwise given permission by the Chair of the Council of Ambassadors.
