

The key to increasing the available workforce in industry – A LSIP priority for the sector

L2 Apprenticeship Standard

- 18 month programme
 - 3 months in college (plus 1-2 weeks if Functional Skills are needed)
 - To complete training on included qualifications and core knowledge and skills needed
 - 1 year in workplace
 - To include assessment visits in the workplace
 - Recording of off the job training hours
 - 3 months on End Point Assessment
- This could be used to train new staff to enter the industry or upskill existing staff on a formal qualification
- The aim is to increase the Semi Skilled workforce
 - To increase the workforce entering industry and then the workforce entering at the Skilled level
